

### Adjectives with 4 Forms (Change for Masc/Fem and Sing/Plural)

These follow the pattern: Masc. Sing. (consonant) \$ Masc. Plural (-i); Fem. Sing. (-ă) Fem. Plural (-e).

Singular (Masc / Fem)	Plural (Masc / Fem)	English Meaning
Bătrân / Bătrână	Bătrâni / Bătrâne	Old
Tânăr / Tânără	Tineri / Tinere	Young
Slab / Slabă	Slabi / Slabe	Thin / Weak
Gras / Grasă	Grași / Grase	Fat
Ieftin / Ieftină	Ieftini / Ieftine	Cheap
Curat / Curată	Curăți / Curate	Clean
Harnic / Harnică	Harnici / Harnice	Hardworking
Leneș / Leneșă	Leneși / Leneșe	Lazy

### Adjectives with 3 Forms (Special Plurals)

These often end in -u or -ou in masculine and follow specific plural rules for the feminine.

Singular (Masc / Fem)	Plural (Masc / Fem)	English Meaning
Nou / Nouă	Noi / Noi	New
Aclu / Aclă	Acru / Acre	Sour
Greu / Greuă	Grei / Grele	Heavy / Difficult

### Adjectives with 2 Forms (End in -e)

These only have one form for both genders in the singular, and one form for both genders in the plural (ending in -i).

Singular (Masc & Fem)	Plural (Masc & Fem)	English Meaning
Mare	Mari	Big

Singular (Masc & Fem)	Plural (Masc & Fem)	English Meaning
Subțire	Subțiri	Thin
Rece	Reci	Cold
Dulce	Dulci	Sweet
Verde	Verzi	Green

### Adjectives with 1 Form (Invariable)

These never change, regardless of gender or number.

- **Roz** (Pink)
- **Gri** (Grey)
- **Bej** (Beige)
